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Bollard Installation into concrete Instructions

- 1. Lay out the desired location for the bollard placement and mark the ground at the approximate center point.
- 2. Next step is to core drill a hole into the concrete. The diameter of the hole has to be the diameter of the bollard plus 30mm and it should be a minimum of 400mm deep.
- 3. Mix the concrete following the manufacturer's printed directions on the bag label.
- 4. Insert the bollard into the hole and use a level to hold it plumb.
- 5. Shovel the concrete mix into the hole around the perimeter of the bollard. Tap the bollards side with a rubber mallet or hammer as you insert the concrete mix to help pack the mix. Fill the mix up to the ground level.
- 6. The concrete mix has to cure for a minimum of 48 hours to complete the bollard installation.
